#### Requesting a HER Search:

A Historic Environment Record Search is an ideal starting point when looking to consider the historic environment with your Neighbourhood Plan. This will provide mapping and information and all recorded heritage assets within your Neighbourhood Area, alongside historic mapping and information on all available sources. This will allow you to consider both the condition and character of the heritage assets, alongside identifying opportunities and priorities for enhancing the local evidence base. A search will be provided free of charge for each Neighbourhood Planning community.
