

# OBJECTIVES

## The plan should encourage:

1 Appropriate new house building which meets the current and future needs of a changing and growing community, which encompasses high quality design and is suitable for both young and old accessing and downsizing in the housing market

2 Controlled development focussing new development to small scale house building so that the purpose of the green belt is maintained across the parish and prevents encroachment with nearby major urban areas

3 Improved services facilities and amenities that will; help to improve quality of life, create a sense of well-being, reduce fear of crime, promote community safety and enable active and healthy lifestyles by providing safe, accessible and adequate services and facilities to meet the needs of parish residents

4 A mix of local businesses appropriate to the character of the area, serving the needs of local people and contributing to the wider economy through employment opportunities that include small retail/office businesses and services and support for the rural economy in the countryside.

5 A variety of leisure, cultural and sporting activities to provide new and diverse leisure and recreational activities and facilities for all, particularly youngsters and older people with the availability of community-use buildings and land to host these

6 A better integrated public transport system serving the growing and changing community well, based on safe roads, pedestrian walkways, some cycle routes, and effective traffic management

7 Protection of the natural and historic environment in support of educational, recreational and conservation purposes, with improved access to the countryside for all including families and people with limited mobility with disabilities

8 Promotion of Safe Environmentally Friendly Developments designed to meet the latest energy efficiency standards and making best use of schemes promoting renewable energy sources and ensuring waste is managed effectively.
