

# MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF LICKEY AND BLACKWELL PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON MONDAY 15<sup>th</sup> MARCH 2021 AT 7.30PM VIA ZOOM Minutes No.10 2020/21

The Meeting was adjourned for Public Question time.

Sue Hughes of Lickey Community Group asked the Council if there had been any further news on Marlbrook Tip as some residents had reported sightings of large trucks near the site. Council replied that there has been no notification from the District Council.

Roy Hughes of Lickey Community Group asked the Council if planters or pots could be considered for Old Birmingham Road verges. Cllr Webb explained that verges would be repaired in April and it may be possible to obtain licences and planters with her assistance and PC/volunteers would have to maintain them.

Keith Woolford of Lickey Community Group queried the 2% rise on the precept. Cllr P Harvey indicated that all spending was explained in the budget.

## 3. REPORTS FROM OUTSIDE BODIES, COUNTY & DISTRICT COUNCILLORS:

Cllr S Webb reported on current Covid figures at 69 per 100,000 in Bromsgrove. The planting of trees on Old Birmingham Road verges would not be possible due to roots in utilities in the past. Cllr Webb met with residents on this issue as well as to discuss speeding on Lickey Rock, she will be requesting pedestrian signs for either end.

Cllr J King reported on Bromsgrove District Council's planning decisions and that the Whitford Road development had been agreed by the inspector as well as the upcoming discussion of the Perryfield application. The Artrix to be used as a vaccination centre for 249 days and a partnership on future management of the Artrix to begin with Birmingham University.

Cllr Deeming was called away before he was able to give his report.

7.1 Cllr J Harvey reported on the arrangements for the Annual Report newsletter which will be mainly an electronic version, we will put a QR code on the noticeboards to link to it and provide paper copies to anyone who requests one. We hope to run the Best Front Garden competition in September and Christmas events in December as usual.
